Entry Fee: \$4.00 per photograph entered (cash only) limit of 3 photos per person; one in each category.

Rules and Specifications:

- Photograph entries must have been taken by the entrant, using a camera or cell phone.
- Minimal digital editing is acceptable (adjusting color, contrast, and cropping is OK).
- Due to space limitations, restrict the overall size to no larger than 11" x 14" (including any mat used).
- Photos must be mounted on stiff backer board, foamboard, or matted. No glass or frames, please.
- Please place identifying information on the back of each photo (your name, contact information, and category entered). Please do **NOT** tape your entry form to the back of the photo.
- Photographers should complete an application (below) and submit it with their photos at the Weaver "Photo Barn," located in Camp Area H, across from the restrooms, on Thursday, October 5th between 3:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m., or make special arrangements for early drop-off with a Focus Point member.
- Winners will be awarded ribbons for first, second, and third places, and the Atwood Festival will award plaques for first and second places.
- Every effort will be made to ensure the safety and security of all submitted photographs. However, neither Focus Point, nor the Atwood Fall Festival Committee, nor the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District will be liable for any damages to submitted photos.
- Retrieval of photographs will be on Sunday, October 8th, from 3:00 p.m. until festival closing time of 5:00 p.m., unless other arrangements are made.
