

# Atwood Area Fall Festival

## Antique Engines Rules and Regulations

The Atwood Area Fall Festival invites you to display in and enjoy the Atwood Fall Festival. To ensure the safety and enjoyment of the festival for exhibitors and attendees our exhibitors need to follow some safety and courtesy rules. Exhibitors are defined as anyone displaying in the antique engine area and/or anyone affiliated with the Antique engine area. The same rules apply to anyone accompanying the exhibitors. Please remember we are guests of Atwood lake Park and fall under their rules and guidelines along with anyone other rules of the Atwood Area Fall Festival.

Since we have pedestrian traffic and vehicle traffic in the same areas, we have arrival and departure times. This applies to any vehicle of an exhibitor or anyone accompanying them. The following is the schedule of these times.

**Friday - 9:30am to 9:00pm** - You must be parked and no vehicle moved within this time on Friday.

**Saturday - 9:30am to when the Hayride is completed** - You must be parked and no vehicle moved within this time on Saturday. We are offering an Early leave time on Saturday for exhibitors which will be 6:00pm until 6:30pm. You must make prior arrangements to leave at this time and you will be escorted through the festival area as a safety precaution. There will also be a late arrival time with and escort through the festival. Anyone arriving after 9:30am must park in a designated staging area until approximately 12:00pm. At this time, you will be escorted into the antique engine area. When you enter the gate please inquire where the staging area is located.

**Sunday - 9:30am to 5:00pm** - You must be parked and no vehicle moved within this time on Sunday.

There is general parking for our attendees that can be used by antique engine exhibitors. Do not park in the car show area. Anyone that might need to leave other than the approved times must park in general parking. There are limited golf carts and trolleys that run at limited times between the parking areas and the festival area. You are welcome to get a ride on them to access your vehicle.

There is a registration form to be completed by the exhibitors and anyone accompanying the exhibitors. Everyone must register upon arrival. Do not set up until you register and are placed by an appropriate volunteer.

There is a \$15 per night camping fee. This fee starts the night that you first stay. You can only camp until Sunday, not overnight Sunday. You only have to pay the camping fee if you stay overnight. You are more than welcome to leave your display overnight and not pay the camping fee. The camping fee is due at registration, upon your arrival.

There are no golf carts, atvs, utvs, or other off road vehicles other than Atwood Area Fall festival and MWCD vehicles permitted in festival areas.

There shall be no driving displays or vehicles in festival area during festival hours.

We will be offering a parade that starts at 3:00 pm and ends at 3:30pm on Saturday and Sunday. Everyone is welcome to drive their displays in this parade, as long as, it is conducted in a safe and controlled manner.
